CUMBRIA'S MUSEUM OF MILITARY LIFE



Located within the walls of historic Carlisle Castle, Cumbria's Museum of Military Life tells the story of the county's Regimental history from 1702, through two World Wars, to present day. The Museum's principal collection includes items associated with the 34th and 55th Regiments of Foot, The Border Regiment, King's Own Royal Border Regiment, and The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment (Kings, Lancashire and Border). This rich history is told through a wealth of objects and enhanced by excellent audio-visual displays.


Come and see the French Drum Major's Mace captured by Sergeant Moses Simpson in 1811, learn how Sergeant Edward Mott was awarded the Victoria Cross in 1917, see the message in a bottle thrown overboard just before the D-Day landings in 1944, find out about Lance Corporal Ashley Irving's near miss in Afghanistan in 2009, and hear more of the stories of 'ordinary people doing extraordinary things'.

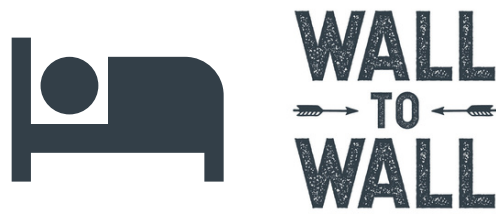

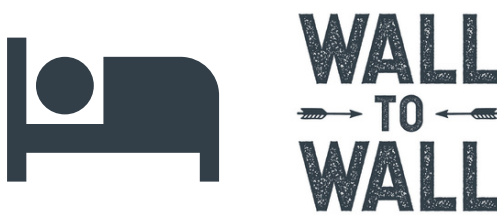

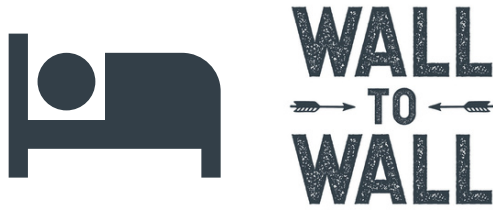

Weaver Hall Museum and workhouse tells stories of the history and industry of west Cheshire through films, reconstructions, models and displays of artefacts. Galleries relate to local industry, market towns, transport, archaeology, and the building’s former history - the old Northwich union workhouse. CLIFFORD'S TOWER



Built to subdue the rebellious north by William the Conqueror, Clifford’s Tower has been a royal mint, a medieval stronghold and a Civil War garrison. In 1190, one of the worst antisemitic massacres of the Middle Ages took place on the site of the tower when York’s Jewish community were trapped there by a violent mob and many Jews chose to commit suicide rather than be murdered. Today, a new roof deck gives unrivalled views over York’s historic skyline, with its medieval buildings and famous Minster. Inside, new walkways and staircases have opened up parts of the tower that have been off-limits for centuries, and immersive soundscapes and stories are bringing the tower’s turbulent history to life like never before.

Clifford’s Tower has re-opened following a major £5 million project by English Heritage to conserve and radically transform the interior of the 800-year-old landmark.

New interpretation vividly brings to life the rich and varied history of Clifford’s Tower.

Hear the stories of those who lived and breathed in the castle in a unique soundscape that will transport you back in time.

Experience areas of the castle that have not been accessible for centuries on new

Climb to the top of the new roof deck offering amazing 360-degree panoramas of the city of York. Enjoy unrivalled views of the Minster, the medieval city and beyond.

Outside the tower, a Piaggio (a quirky tuk-tuk like vehicle) is stationed at the base of the motte. This displays an animation of the tower interior and its transformation, for visitors unable to access the site via the stairway. A permanent tactile map and information in Braille is at the base. Visitors can also pick up hand-held tactile maps from the Piaggio.

The stairs leading up to the tower have new seated areas where visitors can stop, rest and take in the view. There is further seating at the base of the stairs as well as within the tower.

Inside an audio description tour is available via a series of QR codes. This provides text panel information, a description of the tower and navigation support. Hearing loops have been integrated within the audio seating to hear the fascinating history of this castle area.

WHITBY ABBEY



Set high on the clifftops overlooking the sea, the ruins of Whitby Abbey tell only part of the site’s incredible story. Communities have lived on this headland for over 3,000 years and it has long been an important oly place and seat of power.
