Liverpool & Chester

DAY 5

Llandudno & Llangollen

Today we cross the border into beautiful North Wales. Our day starts at the Victorian seaside town, Llandudno, renowned for its sweeping bay and Victorian era architecture. Next, we make our way to the picturesque Llangollen Wharf, where we board our canal boat, the Thomas Telford. Enjoy peaceful cruising through the stunning Dee Valley, which has rightfully been awarded World Heritage Status. During our cruise we are served a delicious Afternoon Tea. This evening is at leisure.

Snowdonia

DAY 7

Stratford-upon-Avon

Tonight, Stratford is yours to explore at leisure.

Cotswolds & Oxford
